On-line "Update Spring 2007 Herd Inventories" at www.redangus.org, under REDS

Spring 2007 Herd Inventories were mailed from the National Office the first week in January. They need to be returned postmarked no later than February 10, 2007 with all changes, additions, and corrections.

If no changes are to be made to your Herd Inventory, we still need to know this information. Therefore, please mark it correct and return to the National Office or go to the web site and click on the button 'No Change - Process'.

The Association will bill the Spring 2007 annual THR assessments based on your Herd Inventory that is returned to the National Office. We do encourage you to keep a copy of your Herd Inventory for your records, which you can then check when you receive your Spring 2007 annual assessment billing on the July statement.

Remember that when you submit updates via the web site the information will not automatically be updated in the database. All herd inventories will be updated by March 1st. Therefore, please do

not resubmit information if changes are not seen on the web site. We encourage you to contact the office if you want to double check that your herd inventory updates have been received in the National Office.

Barn Sheets / Ultrasound data collection

Members who have animals on inventory eligible for the collection of ultrasound information will need to request 'barn sheets' from the web site or contact the office. The barn sheets are provided for the technician to record data to be sent to the lab. DO NOT send the barn sheets to the National Office with information.

Fall 2006 Heifer Exposure Inventory

The inventory for Fall heifer exposure information was mailed out the middle of November, 2006 and is due back in the National Office postmarked no later than February 17, 2007.

Fall 2006 calf crop, March 1st - Pre-listed weaning worksheets

These worksheets will be mailed out around the 1st week in March for members to submit their Fall 2006 calf records (include calves which died before weaning), as well as reason and disposal codes for females that do not have a calf record.

Registration Status - Compute Option

- Intended for submitting calf data to fulfill THR progeny performance requirements in the case when calves are not intended to be kept as registered breeding stock, progeny data from commercial cattle in designed progeny test programs, animals from other breeds or registries.
- No performance certificates will be issued
- They will not have EPDs, nor will they be eligible for transfer
- Calves at a compute status may be moved to registered status provided they have met all the requirements for registration status

Change in the Order of RAAA EPDs
