The Red Angus Association of America is pleased to award a minimum of four \$1000 college scholarships through the support of the Red Angus Foundation, Inc. The following criteria will be used to determine eligibility:

1. Applicant must be a current JRA member in good standing with the RAAA at the time of application.
2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or a current college freshman with definite plans to enroll in post-secondary education in the fall of the application year.
3. Complete applications must be postmarked by **February 15** of the application year. Incomplete and/or late applications will not be considered. Applications may be emailed if received by 11:59 p.m. Central Time February 15th.
4. Scholarship awards are not limited to one year, last year's recipients may submit a scholarship application for the current year.
