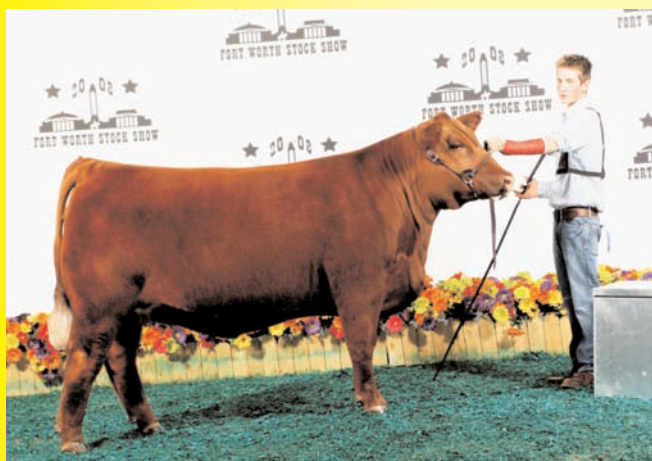

## ARE YOU READY TO BE A LEADER? JRA Officer Candidates Needed!

Each year, three positions on the six member JRA Board are open for election. In 2008, the three regions with open JRA officer positions are:

**West** region - Alaska, California, Hawaii, Idaho, Nevada, Oregon, Washington

**Mountains** region - Colorado, Montana, Utah, Wyoming

**South** region - Alabama, Arkansas, Arizona, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, New Mexico, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas

Applicants for the JRA Board must be **16 years of age**; **must have attended at least one Round-Up** prior to year of application; **must be present at the 2008 Round-Up** and **must have a continuous JRA membership for two years** prior to year of application.

\*\*Applications must be completed and received by May 1, 2008.

# JRA AMERICAN/CANADIAN EXCHANGE PROGRAM

Each year, the JRA and the Canadian Junior Angus Association cooperate in an exchange program by sending representatives from each association to the summer Junior event. Canadian Juniors attend Round-Up; JRA members attend the Canadian Junior Showdown. This is a fun and unique opportunity for JRA members - to attend and participate in Showdown.

Applications are available to all JRA members, 16 years of age and older. JRA representatives will travel, unaccompanied, to Canada either by air or car-pool.

The 2008 Canadian Junior Showdown will be July 17-20, Spruce Meadows, Calgary, AB. JRA representatives will arrive on July 16 and return July 21.
