4:00 - 5:30 p.m. . Gather at sale facility/social/informal cattle viewing

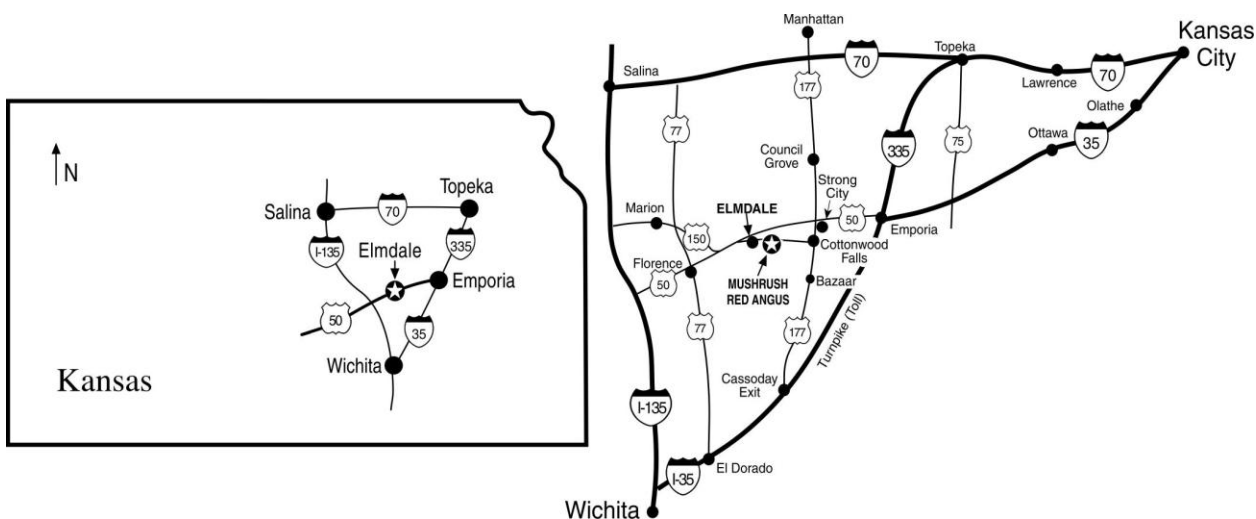

Directions from Elmdale: One mile East on the paved county road across Cottonwood River bridge to **top** of the hill. Turn left or north to get to the barn. Watch for the overhead sign to your left.

From Cottonwood Falls: Turn west on Main Street (first street south of the river bridge). Continue west for four miles. The sale barn overlooks a valley to your right. There is an overhead sign at the entrance.
