The top-selling open heifer was Lot 17, Flying W Annie 128B, a May 10, 2014, daughter of Flying W Xtra 111X, consigned by Flying W Red Angus of Cooperstown, N.D. She sold to Wildcat Creek Ranch of Newton, Kan., for \$10,000 and was also named the Reserve Spring Calf Champion.

Lot 32, MLK CRK Lakota 405, a Feb. 12, 2014, daughter of Andras Fusion R236, sold for \$7,000 to Arrowsmith Red Angus of Baldwin, Neb. She was consigned by Milk Creek Reds of Plevna, Mont., and stood second in her class.

Lot 3, 3C Poker Face 1438, a Feb. 16, 2014, daughter of WEBR TC Card Shark 1015, sold for \$5,250 to Fischer Red Angus of Harlowtown, Mont. She was consigned by 3C Red Angus of Stevensville, Mont.

The top-selling bred heifer was Lot 15, Feddes Blockana 9144 A33, a Jan. 26, 2013, daughter of FED FLIKK Mulberry X648. She sold for \$11,500 to Walnut Springs Farm of Hopkins, Mich. She was consigned by Feddes Red Angus of Manhattan, Mont., and was named the Reserve Champion Futurity Heifer.

Lot 33, MLK CRK Lakota 320, a Feb. 16, 2013, daughter of C-T Grand Statement 1025, sold for \$7,750 to Mahlen Red Angus of Froid, Mont. She was consigned by Milk Creek Reds of Plevna, Mont.

Lot 9, BCRR Pamela 390A, a March 18, 2013, daughter of Red Fine Line Mulberry 26P, sold to Mahlen Red Angus of Froid, Mont., for \$7,500. She was consigned by Bullis Creek Ranch of Wood Lake, Neb., and stood second in her class in the Red Angus Junior Show.

The top embryo package was Lot 23 consigned by Klompfen Red Angus of Manhattan, Mont. The embryos were sired by FCC Rambo 502 and out of DKK Auburn P35. Ravishing Reds of North Platte, Neb., purchased the package for \$2,250.

Lot 6X, was the pick of Bowles J5 Red Angus herd of Chinook, Mont. It sold for \$4,000 to Milk Creek Reds of Plevna, Mont.
