The 1st Annual Ladies of Louisville Red Angus Sale was held November 15, 2015 at Kentucky Exposition Center during the North American International Livestock Exposition in Louisville, Kentucky with the sale being managed by Red Cow Relocators. Auctioneer was Monte Lowderman.

13 live animals averaged \$6,319 with individual averages as follows: 7 open heifers averaged \$4,943, 3 bred heifers averaged \$8,417 and 3 bulls averaged \$7,433. Embryo packages averaged \$2,721 a package for 14 packages and semen packages averaged \$570 a package for 4 packages.

The top selling open heifer was Lot 7, DAMAR T701 Dexan 1378 C013 selling for \$9,500. She was sold by DAMAR Farms, Dave & Mary Hehli of Emerald, Wisconsin. She was born 2/3/2015. Her sire is Silveiras Mission Nexus 1378 and Dam is DFRA Dexan T701. She was purchased by Mark Nagel of Trenton, Illinois.

The top selling bred heifer was Lot 9 DAMAR Tarmily 26P B018 selling for \$12,500. She was sold by DAMAR Farms, Dave & Mary Hehli of Emerald, Wisconsin. She was born 1/3/2014.
