

# Committee Extends Call for Board Nominations

**RAAA members who have a vision for the future and a desire to cultivate the business of the Red Angus Association of America will have the opportunity to run for the Board of Directors this September at the National Red Angus Convention in Oklahoma City.**

The Nominating Committee encourages interested members to consider running for those seats that are up for re-election or will be vacated due to term limits. A term is three years with a two-term limit. Directors are elected to the volunteer leadership position in their respective Area or Regional Caucuses during the general session of the convention.

Bob Morton, current director, term expires

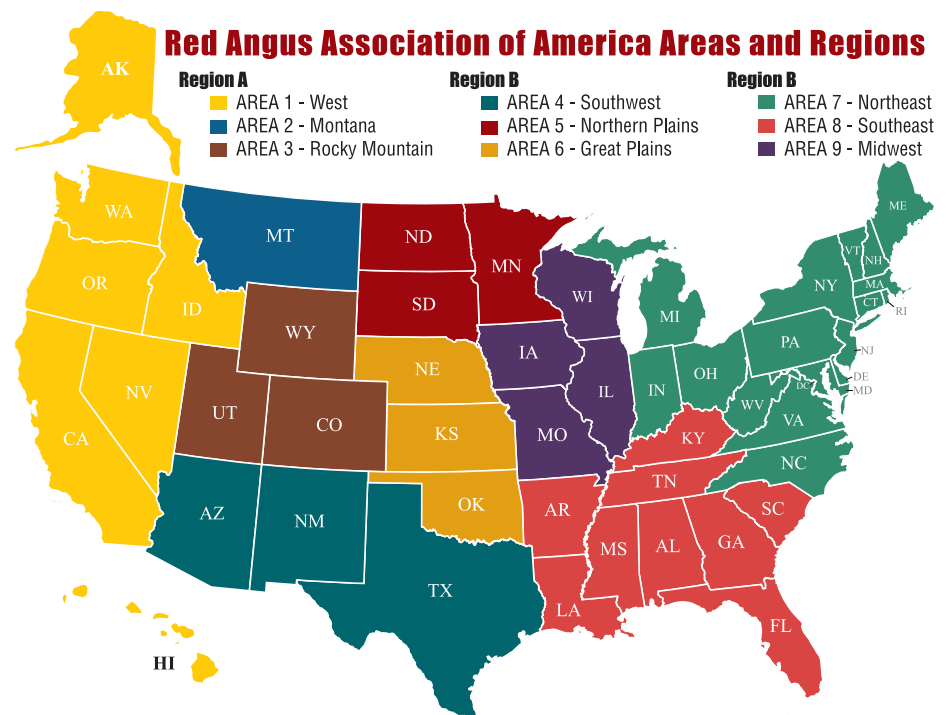
**President** – Elected by the general membership in attendance at convention

## Responsibilities

The BOD leads and oversees the affairs and business of the Association as outlined in the RAAA Bylaws.

RAAA directors are leadership volunteers and are not reimbursed for their time nor receive a salary. Expenses may be compensated for scheduled BOD meetings which are held a minimum of three times a year – January,



June and September. Conference calls are scheduled as required to conduct business between BOD meetings.

The BOD adheres to the Core Policies, Mission and Vision of the RAAA for guidance in all decisions as they follow the course set by the Strategic Plan. Members of the BOD also populate and chair RAAA committees.

Candidates must be residents of – or have a primary mailing address in – the Area or Region they represent, and must be a member of RAAA in good standing for a minimum of three years. The President must be a

member of the current Board of Directors or has served as a director in the past. Complete qualifications are outlined in the RAAA Bylaws.
